DAY 1	ATHOL BAY INNER HARBOUR LOCATIONS • Sydney Harbour Bridge • Opera House • Circular Quay • The Rocks • Darling Harbour	 Welcome onboard your yacht, Lady Pamela. Join Lady Pamela in Sydney Superyacht Marina, Rozelle. Enjoy being welcomed by our friendly crew. Once all aboard and settled in. As you cruise beneath the magnificent Sydney Harbour Bridge and pass the famous Opera House, you'll be greeted with fabulous views of the inner harbour. Cruise into Farm Cove a small bay opposite the Opera House, surrounded by Sydney's Botanical Garden; enjoy lunch while taking in the spectacular view. In late afternoon enjoy a relaxing cruise and watch the sunset from the best vantage point on the harbour, Athol Bay, where the white pristine beach in the inner harbor's Athol Bay awaits you for the evening at anchor. DAY 2	Anchor in Vaucluse Bay or Balmoral Beach LOCATIONS Inner Harbour Athol Bay Watsons Bay Bondi Beach* Balmoral Beach	 As you approach Athol Bay head on from the sea; you will be met by two small beaches, the first of which is surrounded by rocky slopes and a timber jetty. The smaller Whiting Beach is south facing, and with a dense vegetation back drop. A creek babbles along to form a gentle pool, ideal for safe paddling and exploring. Cruise to Doyles Restaurant on the beach at Watsons Bay for a spectacular seafood lunch with views over the harbour and city. If you're looking for serenity; Balmoral Beach is perfect thanks to its relaxing vibe. It's not as lively as Bondi Beach, it's more like a small coastal town. Cruise through Spit Bridge to Middle Harbour and anchor at Sugarloaf Bay, known for its beautiful secluded anchorages. Relax surrounded by nature, protected from the wind — paddleboard, kayak or enjoy good fishing holes. Cruise around to the unspoilt Bantry Bay for the evening. 4	Little Manly Cove LOCATIONS • Manly • Little Manly Cove	No yacht charter adventure in Sydney is complete without visiting the Australian suburb of Manly. Pass back through the Spit Bridge and anchor at Little Manly Cove. Enjoy a coffee in the laid-back beach town of Manly, then hike or mountain bike around the pristine bushland at North Head Nature Reserve. With a relaxed holiday vibe, Manly is packed with long golden sand beaches that offer spectacular coastal views and attract hundreds of surfers. Whether you wish to try surfing, head ashore and visit the Little Manly Cove, or swim in the sheltered Shelly Beach, Manly offers something for every traveler on Lady Pamela. The crew can put on a traditional Aussie barbecue anchored on a secluded beach in Cowan Creek. Spend the night at scenic Jerusalem Bay. In the afternoon, there are some excellent bays for swimming, waterskiing and paddle boarding. You can try your luck at fishing as this is the main water activity here. A series of quiet anchorages offers ideal conditions for a lazy swim in the river. Surrounded by nature, it's a great place to spend the evening.	
DAY 8	Rose Bay LOCATIONS • Bondi Beach • Rose Bay	After breakfast, guests enjoy a swim before the two-hour run south back to Sydney Harbour. If the weather is good, cruise a little further south and visit Bondi Beach before heading back in through the Heads and anchoring in Rose Bay.
